GCOG assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form by the owner or the owner's agent. **ENTRANTS ALONE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMPLETENESS AND ACCURACY OF ALL INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** The Greater Columbia Obedience Club will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- Refunds (minus an administration fee of \$5.00 per class) for bitches in season will be mailed to the Exhibitor after the conclusion of the trial if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

- Dogs must be ready for judging. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

From Charleston via I-26W: From I26W, take exit 116 to merge onto I-77N toward Charlotte. Go 5.0 mi and take exit 5 for Bluff Rd / SC 48W. Turn left at Bluff Rd / SC 48W. Go 2.8 mi and turn right at SC 48W / Rosewood Dr. Entrance to the SC State Fairgrounds will be on the right.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
